When can I go?

What do I need?

- At least 17 years of age at time of application: 18 years of age or older at time of of selection
- Valid Driver's license
- Proof of education (High school diploma, GED or certified transcripts showing graduation date [sealed])
- \$40 application fee (cash or money order)

What do I do?

- Complete general application
- Receive list of dates for standardized written examination
- Schedule and complete examination
 *Receive qualifying score on the examination
- Complete oral interview
- Slotted onto rank list by score
- Receive instructions on the next steps and how to proceed

What they do

Inside Wireman work with conduit made from steel and alternative materials (plastics, fiberglass). They also work with wire made from copper and aluminum. They install, maintain and service components in electrical systems from the utility service to the energy consuming device, including related fixtures.

Inside Wireman also install, maintain and service components used in electrical systems.

What they earn

1st year apprentice starts at \$13.70/hour taxable, \$24.82/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

Apprentices receive a wage rate percentage increase twice each year.

Journeyman earns \$39.13/hour taxable, \$60.39/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).
