- Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- State issued photo ID
- Proof of education (High school diploma, GED or official transcripts showing graduation date [sealed])
- \$35 application fee (cash or money order)

What do I do?

- Complete general application
- Receive list of dates for standardized written examination
- Schedule and complete examination
 *Receive qualifying score on examination
- Complete oral interview
- Slotted onto Rank list by score
- Receive instructions on the next steps and how to proceed

What they do

Tapers work with drywall compound (mud), paper tape, and corner to finish and smooth a drywall installation prior to the application of paint of wall covering

Tapers work in commercial buildings, hospitals, schools and stadiums

What they earn

1st year apprentice starts at \$13.34./hour taxable, \$22.76/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

Apprentices receive a wage rate percentage increase twice each year.

Journeyman earns \$30.10/hour taxable, \$46.95/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).
